# **PTA Membership and School Directory**

We are pleased to announce that for the 2016-2017 school year, the Laurel Park PTA membership process will be paperless! You will be able to purchase your membership and enter your contact information in the PTA directory online.

The Laurel Park PTA will be launching web-based software provided by a company named MySchoolAnywhere (www.myschoolanywhere.com) to manage PTA membership and the PTA online directory. Using this company will provide several benefits for the PTA, LPES parents, and the school such as:

- Streamline the process and allow all LPES parents to enter their family's information directly into the directory database. Once it has been approved by the directory management team, it will be published in the online directory (you can opt out if desired).
- Only PTA members will enjoy additional features such as viewing the online directory from your PC, Laptop, or mobile device and can make edits to your own contact information. An excellent reason to join the PTA!

## How do you access the new online PTA directory?

Once we have received and reviewed your family's information you will receive an email with login instructions. Our plan is to go live a few months after school starts!

What's so great about the online directory?

- It's secure your family will have a unique login and password and the directory can't be lost or stolen.
- You can search by student's first name, grade, teacher and family last name.
- You can create your own custom list of frequently called families.
- You can access the family directory from any internet connected device: your computer, smart phone, iPad, etc.
- This is a directory of PTA families not a school directory. Only PTA members will be listed initially. We hope to expand to all families soon.

## Is it secure?

**YES!** All data is stored behind secure firewalls and can only be accessed by authorized users with a validated username and encrypted password. All data is viewed and passed using SSL encryption.

## How does it work?
